Application

This guideline applies to the state system of community colleges.

Principle

Designates how developmental courses and classes taken for audit (AU) are calculated in GPA.

Guideline

Grades awarded for developmental courses (as defined by CCHE as Basic Skills courses) will not be included in a student's grade point average (GPA). Grading for developmental courses will utilize the Developmental grade mode (S/A, S/B, S/C, U/D, U/F). The credits for developmental courses will count toward earned and attempted credits.

GPA's for term recognition such as President's List, VP List and Dean's List will not include developmental courses in the calculation.

Course credits for which an AU is earned will not count in Attempted Hours and Earned Hours. No Quality Points will be assigned, and there will be no impact on either the Term or Cumulative GPA.
