Application

This guideline applies to the state system of community colleges.

Principle

Designates the necessary guidelines for term academic honors.

Guideline

CCCS Colleges provide an opportunity for students to be recognized with Academic Honors, on a term-by-term basis. Each CCCS College may choose from among the three recognized Honors – Dean’s List, Vice President’s List, and/or President’s List. Each College will identify in its catalog and other official documents, the Honors that are achievable at that College. Students who qualify will receive a notation for that term on their official transcript.

Term Grade Point Averages required to qualify for these Term Academic Honors, are as follows:

- Dean’s List 3.50 to 3.749
- Vice President’s List 3.75 to 3.999
- President’s List 4.00

S/U grades and grades for Developmental Education coursework are not included in the Grade Point Average Calculation. Students must complete a minimum of 12 eligible credit hours in the term to be considered for Term Academic Honors.

Awarding of summer term honors is at the discretion of the college.
