### Follow-up Notes/Agenda

- **Jerry has visited 7 of the 13 colleges. By the first of March he will have visited all colleges. Wants to visit on an informal basis more, but will be visible at least once a year on a formal basis.**
- **GT Pathways courses need to go to CDHE today 2/14/14.**
- **Gen Ed council update:**
  - **Over 4000 classes in the GT, many over 5 years old which is the reason for the break. All under review.**
  - **Spring review in March 2014**
  - **Fall 2014 review will occur**
  - **Possible spring 2015 break if submissions are low**
- **\*MAN150, Andrew Johnson, RRCC**
  - **Took out the “marathon” language from the curriculum**
  - **Questions from the floor:**
    - **Similar to AAA109, has goals included in the curriculum.**
    - **Andrew does agree that some of the goals are similar but that this is a Business course.**

- **Stanton mentioned that NUR courses were approved recently, the old courses will fall off at the beginning of summer, with summer as the effective date.**
  - **Can we change the NUR 134 effective date to Fall instead of Summer? NJC needs to offer the 4.5 credit version this summer. SFCC approved the change and Lauren can make the change.**
- **Calendar/Meeting Dates**
  - **Keep May 2, 2014**
  - **Move August 8<sup>th</sup> to August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 – approved**
  - **Move January 8<sup>th</sup> to January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015 – approved**
- **ART vs PHO – when disciplines don't communicate:**
  - **History: Photography has agreements with articulations, this is the only area SFCC allowed some duplication to occur. The Art Institute would not accept photo courses with an ART prefix, CSU/CU wouldn't allow PHO to articulate/transfer.**
  - **Scott will send a note to Lydia and have her circulate the ART 143/ PHO 120 course. Scott will write something up and send to Lauren.**
  - **PHO is meant more for CTE.**
  - **We do need to remind ART and PHO disciplines why it is this way.**
  - **We, SFCC may need to put together some historical information.**
- **New member from OJC, Tammy Dornekamp – replaces Tamra Collins, OJC**
- **When do courses show up on the BB, how do we get people to review it and have sufficient time for people to review it?**
  - **Lauren says it only gets updated once a month.**
  - **Stanton will talk with the Ed Services group and ask them to make sure all of their faculty are on the correct distribution lists.**

## **CCCNS / CCHE Updates**

- **Legislative**
  - **Bachelor of Science Degree moving through smoothly – possibility it could be on the governor's desk as early as next week. Should be thinking about what it means as an accreditation perspective. What will it look like, which programs will move through as the first. Not to bring forward any which universities may think of as overlap.**
  - **Adjunct Faculty Proposal – Colorado relies heavily on part time instructors. The fiscal price tag is determined by the joint budget council, approximately \$84 million dollars, ours is higher like \$117 million, PERA wasn't factored into it. Could result in a 50% increase in tuition if the funds are not there. Cost is a concern.**
  - **Appropriations – it appears there may be extra dollars. Hard cap, tuition figure we cannot exceed – 6%.**
