- FER new prefix. Fermentation Science. Letter from FRCC BIO Faculty submitted request with justification. SFCC feels the letter is acceptable.
 - Proposed CTE course
 - Concern that Science in the Prefix title would confuse students in thinking this course would be a science elective course. However, keeping the word "science" in the prefix gives it more credibility. This discipline does have a higher education pathway.
- COM 202 vs MTE 110
 - Send to COM discipline for review and feedback. Stephen Collins and Sherry Dewald DC's.
 - Both courses are very similar. FRCC is looking at proposing changing the MTE 110 title. In doing so, the course needs further cleanup. Does one stay or go?
 - Does anyone offer COM 202? Angie will check.
- Auto Tech courses:
 - 19 courses were changed last year.
 - Removed some very basic courses. Now some competencies are being skipped. ASE 151example course. More competencies are required in ASE course content than CCCNS allows.
 - o Necessary changes were per NATEF and reduction of 2 year programs.
 - 5 courses coming up with changes.
 - Allow ASE to write guides with more competencies for safety and NATEF reasons.
- Part Time Instructor hours
 - Due to health care act.
 - Its possible disciplines may be asked to review all courses to identify credit hours and contact hours. Would add one more level to CCCNS.
 - Would require us to revise the system course form.
 - Example: 12 Credits (all lecture) x 2.25 equals how many hours are credited for working. System wide limit. Higher learning/government came up with the 2.25 number. We can exceed number, need approval. CTE contact hours could possible exceed.
 - 85% of our courses would not be a problem, but there are some disciplines with higher contact hours which do create a problem.
 - July 1, 2014 begin tracking

CCCNS / CCHE Updates – Jerry Migler presented:

- GT Pathways courses all approved (AST 150, AST 160, HIS 203, HIS 218, HIS 259, LIT246)
- Nursing Follow up
 - Several will be meeting with the Nursing Directors (3 VPI's and Jerry)
 - Want to develop a process to move forward to make sure we are clear on what the issues are and have an accurate understanding.

The Meeting was adjourned. Next meeting is on August 15, 2014.
